

## ALLOCATION OF DUTIES FOR TRACK JUDGING

When drawing up a Duty Sheet for Track Event the following are duties that should be considered.

100m	Judging, Including last 3(4) Umpires for lane running, Wind Gauge (Where available)
200m	Judging, including last 3 (4) Umpires for lane running, Wind Gauge (Where available)
400m	Judging, Umpires for lane running
800m	Judging, Lap Board & Bell, Break line, Umpires
1500m	Judging, Lap Board & Bell Umpires
Above 1500m	Judging, Lap Board & Bell, Assist Lap Board & Bell, Lap Scorers, Umpires
Sprint Hurdles	Judging, including last 3(4) Umpires for lane running/ hurdling clearance Wind Gauge (Where available)
300m / 400 Hurdles	Judging, Umpires for lane running / hurdling clearance
Steeplechase	Judging, Lap Board & Bell, Assist Lap Board & Bell, Lap Scorers, Umpires for barrier clearance, not forgetting Water Jump
4 X 100m Relay	Judging, Take Over Judges (one In charge at Each) then enough at each take over to cover incoming and outgoing athletes.
4 X 300m /400m Relay	Judging, Break line, Umpires, Take over In and Out (Preferably one inside one outside)

**DON'T FORGET A REFRESHMENT BREAK WHERE POSSIBLE!! (It may be prudent to allocate these first!!)**

**Suggested umpiring initial positions: - for straight races 2 and 4 – and 6 and 8**

**200m - 19 – 22 then 6 and 8**

**circular races - 13 – 17 – 21 and 9 then to 6**

**Other positions can then be determined by the number of umpires still have duties allocated.**

**THESE NATURALLY DEPEND ON THE NUMBER OF JUDGES / UMPIRES AVAILABLE.**
